



DID YOU KNOW THERE'S A PILL THAT CAN PREVENT HIV?

PrEP, which stands for pre-exposure prophylaxis, can help prevent HIV. It involves taking a prescription pill on a regular basis (every day for most people).



It works!

It is extremely rare for a person who uses PrEP correctly to get HIV.

It's safe!

Most people don't experience side effects. Those who experience side effects usually report they are mild and last a few days to weeks.

It's often covered!

Most public and some private drug plans help cover the cost of PrEP.

It's for anyone at risk for HIV!

PrEP can be used by people of all genders and sexual orientations.

Talk to your healthcare provider or your local HIV organization to find out if PrEP makes sense for you.
